

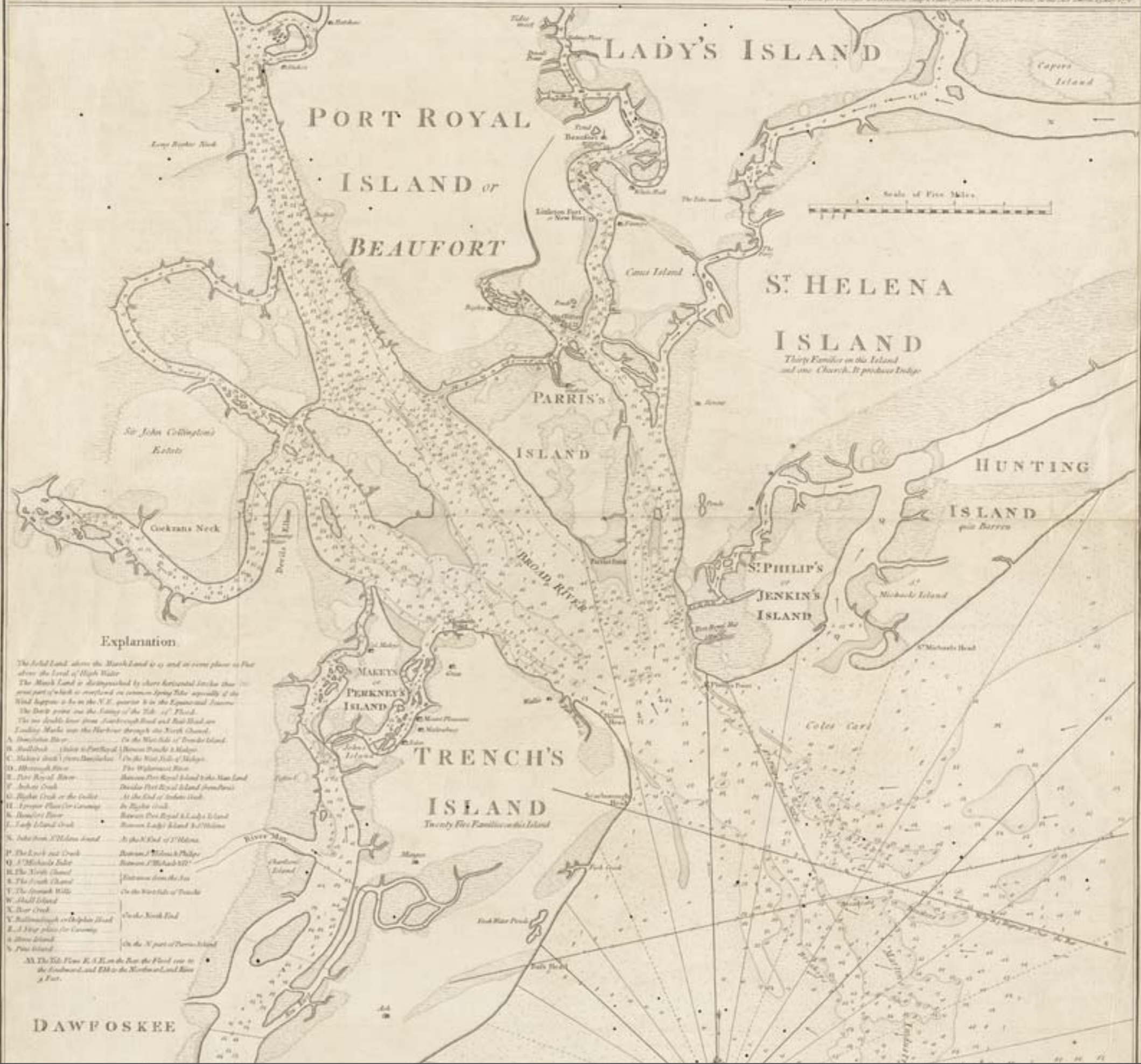

Explanation

The solid Land above the Marsh Land is as and in some places is put above the Level of High Water
 The Marsh Land is distinguished by short horizontal lines the great part of which is overflowed in common Spring Tides especially if the Wind happens to be on the N.E. quarter & in the Equinoctial Seasons.
 The Ditch joins on the S.W. corner to the S.W. of the Island.
 The two double lines from South-west Head and East Head are Landing Marks over the Harbour through the North Channel.
 A. Duckwater River. In the West Side of Duckwater Island.
 B. Bullhead. In the N.W. corner of Hilton Head & Mather.
 C. Mather's Creek. From Duckwater. In the West Side of Mather.
 D. Mather's River. The Watercourse River.
 E. Port Royal River. Between Port Royal Island & the Main Land.
 F. Archer's Creek. Between Port Royal Island & Hilton Head.
 G. Philips Creek or the Outlet. At the End of Philips Head.
 H. Express Channel or Causeway. In Philips Head.
 I. Duckwater River. Between Port Royal & Lady's Island.
 J. Lady's Island Creek. Between Lady's Island & Hilton Head.
 K. Inhabitant of Hilton Head. At the N. End of Hilton Head.
 L. The East end Creek. Between Hilton Head & Philips.
 M. J. Michael's Inlet. Between J. Michael's Head & Hilton Head.
 N. The North Channel. Entrance from the Sea.
 O. The South Channel. Entrance from the Sea.
 P. The Spanish Mills. On the West Side of Duckwater.
 Q. Shell Island.
 R. Bear Creek.
 S. Bullwhacker or Dolphin Head. On the North End.
 T. A High place for Causeway.
 U. Stone Island. On the N. part of Trench's Island.
 V. Pine Island.

M. The Tide Flows E. S. E. on the Sea the Flood runs to the Southward and E. S. E. on the Northward Land Runs a Foot.

PENN SCHOOL

One of the first schools for blacks in the South. Penn School, opened in 1862, was reorganized as Penn Normal, Industrial and Agricultural School in 1901. As a result of this change, incorporating principles of education found at both Tuskegee and Hampton institutes, Penn became an international model. Its program was removed to the Beaufort County school system in 1948.
