
- Methodology: Public health& planning
- Trainers: MDH & Hennepin County
- Evaluation
- 40 Attendees/24 agencies
  - PH professionals
  - City/county planners
  - Engineers
  - Landscape architects
  - Lawyer

- Pre evaluation:
  - 93% little to no experience w/ HIAs
- Post evaluation (n=29)
  - Group exercises most important
  - Level of knowledge gained1-5 (5=expert): 54%-3 |48%-4
  - 96% would recommend training to their colleagues



### TRAINING GOAL: REACH 50% OF MN CHBS

- 53 Community Health Boards (CHBs)
- Reached 22 to date
- o 5 more to go!






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


# MINI-GRANTS DULUTH COMPLETE STREETS POLICY






6<sup>th</sup> Avenue East conceptual re-design project



## HIAS: METRO-AREA COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING PROCESS

- 7-county metro area
   pop = 2,846,576
- 46% of state's pop
- Planning required every 10 years by State law
- 189 jurisdictions in the metro area
- Transportation, aviation, water resources, regional parks and open space systems

## HIAS: MN ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT WORKSHEET (EAWS)

- All major built projects/ landuse changes are assessed through an EAW and/or EIS
- 100-150/year
- FY 08/09-208 projects:
  - highway (~27)
  - feedlot (~25)
  - commercial (~18)
  - residential (~18)
  - nonmetallic (~18)





#### Successes & Opportunities

- Health professionals and planners are eager to work with one another
- Potential to influence Complete Street policy implementation
- Reviewing 7-county metropolitan area comprehensive plans for health has not been done before
- EAW
- Introduction of legislation—Minnesota Healthy Communities Act (MHCA)



#### CHALLENGES

- Political barriers to influence policy change at the regional and state level
- Language barriers between disciplines
- We need to work harder to bring together other disciplines, such as engineers and developers
- Knowledge and experience with HIAs varies greatly
- HIAs are still new in MN—additional training/ education is needed
- Evaluation is lacking



#### RESULTS OF FUNDING TO DATE

- Built relationships with other state, local & federal agencies/ organizations
- Trained over 100 state and local professionals, representing over 40 different organizations
- Able to provide technical assistance
