### **Construction Careers Approach**

- Promote Project Labor Agreements coupled with targeted-hire, as they are proven to be more successful at increasing access to middle-class construction careers for local communities





#### **Construction Careers Victories**

Community Redevelopment Agency (2008)

• 10 Projects covered before agency dissolution

City of Los Angeles
Department of Public Works
(2011)

- 104 Projects
- Over \$2 billion in construction

Port of Los Angeles (2011)

- 42 Projects
- Over \$1.5 billion in Construction

Exposition Line Construction Authority (2011)

- \$1.6 billion
- Utility relocation, maintenance yard facility, light rail construction

Metro (2012)

- \$ 6 billion in construction
- 17 Projects (Crenshaw/LAX, Westside Subway Extension, Regional Connector




## Metro Construction Careers Policy

 Approved by Board of Directors in Jan 2012

- 5-year PLA on projects over \$2.5 million
- 40% targeted hire
- 10% disadvantaged workers








