


Implement Anchor Institutional Strategy

- Majority of LCC employment growth will be in the health care sector
- 30% of LCC residents of working age do not have a high school diploma
- A **high school diploma** qualifies someone for 35% of the jobs in health care...
- 2 more years of school give access to 85% of health care jobs











Create mixed-income neighborhoods with 50% affordable housing

- •Create an affordability target for each phase of housing revitalization goals
- •Leverage programs to support rehabilitation of scattered site, traditional housing for rental
- •Work with hospitals to leverage demand for worker housing
