# Restoring the Environment and Developing Youth (*READY*)

Creating green jobs for young adults, working to improve watershed health through reduction of stormwater runoff







- Jobs for young adults
  - Unemployment rate higher than average
- Impervious surfaces create stormwater
  - Pollutants & sediment carried to rivers/streams
  - Regulations to reduce pollutants & sediment
- Increase public awareness

## 2014 Summer Program

- Hired 44 young adults, 16-26 years old
- Training: 2 weeks for Crew Leaders, 1 week for Crew Members
  - Topics such as leadership, domain knowledge, work skills, safety, policies
- Organization:
  - 6 Crews (Crew Leader plus 5-6 Crew Members each)
  - 2 Drivers
  - 2 Rain Garden Designers
  - 1 Operations Manager
- Customers are non-profit organizations
  - E.g., congregations, schools, homeowner associations
- Workday: 7AM-3PM, 5 days/week, 8 weeks for Crew Members
- Environmental Education Days





## What is a Rain Garden?


- A rain garden catches runoff from rooftops, driveways, and parking lots
- Shallow depression and sandy soil mix allow water to soak into the ground
- Reduces water getting to stormwater systems
- ponding depti overflow inlet soft soil mix ©Illustration courtesy of Rodica Prato

## Making a Difference

- 126 job positions created in the summers of 2012-2014
- 90+ rain gardens, conservation landscapes
- 40+ locations
- 400,000 sq. ft. of impervious surfaces treated
- 825,000 sq. ft. of drainage areas
- Launched Full-Time READY Crew
- Public encounters: talks, exhibits, church services, council meetings, etc.
