The East Coast is also home to the majority of food hubs in the United States, thirty-eight of which are in the D.C. vicinity. Washington, D.C. is at the center of a network of agricultural production and distribution. And yet, the district continues to import 97% of products consumed, and is one of the most food insecure places in the country. Washington, D.C. doesn't need another typical food hub, it needs an organization and a facility that will allow existing food hubs to operate more efficiently and more effectively. Washington, D.C. needs a food union.
