Train

- Race, Class, & Gender Analysis Provide tools to analyze policies through a multidimensional justice lens.
- Content Knowledge Gain a deeper understanding of regional policies in the areas of housing, transportation and land use.
- Commissioner Skills Acquire skills necessary to become an effective advocate commissioner, such as Robert's Rules, inside/outside strategy and power mapping.
- Networking Create opportunities to meet local decisionmakers, including BCLI alumni.








• EJ training, green jobs, reduce impact of projects, culturally competent stakeholder engagement


Community Benefits Policy
