Watershed Restoration Technician Training

16 week training program includes in 80 hours of classroom style training sessions, 25 4-6 hour field work days, 12 fields trips and 20+ annual Community Engagement activities.



Basins of Relations introduces new leaders to watershed stewardship and restoration starting in their own backyards



Then takes Apprentices upstream, where they can go deeper, learning about healthy ecosystems, native flora and fauna, erosion control techniques, the impacts of development and environmental justice.



Finally, coming full circle by engaging with solutions such as Green Infrastructure & Complete Streets and introducing these young people to the local professionals who have the access and ability to make change.



Community Engagement

In the 1st 2 years of the program we engaged over 778 community members in excursions and learning activities that helped to reconnect the larger community to the creeks, marshes and shorelines that surround them.
